DISPOSABLE FILM FESTIVAL BIKE-IN SUMMER TOUR DATES ANNOUNCED

SAN FRANCISCO, California (August 4, 2010) – The Disposable Film Festival’s iconic Bike-In is going on a world tour this summer. Stops include Pittsburgh, PA, London, England, Los Angeles, CA, and Portland, OR. The program follows the massive success of the 2nd Annual San Francisco Bike-In by the festival in May of 2010, and will boast an encore presentation of the DFF’s 2010 Competitive Shorts.

Says festival Co-Founder Carlton Evans, “The Bike-Ins are popular because they’re about re-imagining the intersection between filmmakers who use new media, and how the community goes to see the final product. In the past people went to drive-ins to see films, locked in their own cars without much interaction with the rest of the world. This generation uses public transportation or rides bikes to get around. A bike-in is an open space where people can talk to each other once they arrive.” Evans is “thrilled” to be bringing the tour outside of San Francisco.

The tour is supported by new festival partner [Globe Bikes](#), a brand of bicycles whose “products are inspired by and designed for urban cyclists, commuters, city dwellers, the progressively minded and the eco-conscious.” The brand’s values parallel those of the film fest “perfectly,” says Evans.
